Gender Across Languages Apr 13 2021 This is the third of a three-volume comprehensive reference work on "Gender across Languages", which provides systematic descriptions of various categories of gender (grammatical, lexical, referential, social) in 30 languages of diverse genetic, typological and socio-cultural backgrounds. Among the issues discussed for each language are the following: What are the structural properties of the language that have an impact on the relations between language and gender? What are the consequences for areas such as agreement, pronominalisation and word-formation? How is specification of and abstraction from (referential) gender achieved in a language? Is empirical evidence available for the assumption that masculine/male expressions are interpreted as generics? Can tendencies of variation and change be observed, and have alternatives been proposed for a more equal linguistic treatment of women and men? This volume (and the previous two volumes) will provide the much-needed basis for explicitly comparative analyses of gender across languages. All chapters are original contributions and follow a common general outline developed by the editors. The book contains rich bibliographical and indexical material. Clitics in the wild Feb 21 2022 This collective monograph is the first data-oriented, empirical in-depth study of the system of clitics on Bosnian, Croatian and Serbian. It fills the gap between the theoretical and normative literature by including solid data on variation found in dialects and spoken language and obtained from massive Web Corpora and speakers' acceptability judgements. The authors investigate three primary sources of variation: inventory, placement and morphological processes. A separate part of the book is dedicated to the phenomenon of clitic climbing, the major challenge for any syntactic theory. The theory of complexity serves as the explanation for the very diverse constraints on clitic climbing established in the empirical studies. It allows to construct a series of hierarchies where the factors relevant for predicting clitic climbing interact with each other. Thus, the study pushes our understanding of clitics away from fine-grained descriptions and syntactic generalisations towards a probabilistic modelling of syntax.

Complex Adpositions in European Languages May 15 2021 While much attention has been devoted to simple nominal relators, especially prepositions and case markers, complex nominal relators have not yet been the focus of a systematic and cross-linguistic study. The chapters of this volume provide not only a working definition of such constructions, but also a description of complex adpositions and other complex nominal relators in a variety of European languages, both Indo-European and non-Indo-European, including some languages for which this phenomenon had received little attention, such as Breton and Albanian. Building on synchronic and diachronic corpus-based investigations, the authors show commonalities and specificities of these linguistic items across languages, trying to explain why and how they emerged. The research presented in this volume confirms the wide-spread use of complex adpositions in Europe, and the data reviewed in the final discussion suggests it might be the same in other parts of the world, as well. This book thus offers not only detailed descriptions of complex nominal relators in fifteen languages, but also indications of what to look for in other languages, and how to distinguish between a syntactically free sequence and a genuine complex nominal relator.

Introduction to the Croatian and Serbian Language Nov 28 2019 Introduction to the Croatian and Serbian Language provides an introduction to the language traditionally called Serbo-Croatian, although it is also referred to as Serbian or Croatian. There are two main variants of the language: Croatian (Western) and Serbian (Eastern). In its equal treatment of the two principal variants, this book presents the two alphabets used (Latin and Cyrillic), the representation of lexical items specific to each variant, and pronunciation and syntactic differences. A dictionary is also included.

Advances in Functional Linguistics Sep 18 2021 This collection carries the functionalist Columbia School of linguistics forward with contributions on linguistic theory, semantics, phonology, grammar, lexicon, and anthropology. Columbia School linguistics views language as a symbolic tool whose structure is shaped both by its communicative function and by the characteristics of its users, and considers contextual, pragmatic, physical, and psychological factors in its analyses. This volume builds upon three previous Columbia School anthologies and further explores issues raised in them, including fundamental theoretical and analytical questions. And it raises new issues that take Columbia School "beyond its origins." The contributions illustrate both consistency since the school's inception over thirty years ago and innovation spurred by groundbreaking analysis. The volume will be of interest to all functional linguists and historians of linguistics. Languages analyzed include Byelorussian, English, Japanese, Serbo-Croatian, Spanish, and Swahili.

Za analizu je odabrano šest gramatika - tri iz Srbije i tri iz Hrvatske: 1) Mihailo Stevanović: „Savremeni srpskohrvatski jezik (gramatički sistemi i književnojezička norma) I, Uvod, Fonetika, Morfologija“, 2) Pavica Mrazović i Zora Ivankadinović: „Gramatika srpskohrvatskog jezika za strance“, 3) Živojin Stanović i Ljubomir Popović: „Gramatika srpskoga jezika (Udžbenik za I, II, III i IV razred srednje škole)“, 4) Van Brabec, Mate Hraste, Sreten Živković: „Gramatika hrvatskosrpskoga jezika“, 5) Eugenija Barić, Mijo Lončarić, Dragica Malić, Slavko Pavešić, Mirko Peti, Vesna Zečević, Marija Znaka: „Priručna gramatika hrvatskoga književnog jezika“, 6) Stjepan Babić, Dalibor Brozović, Milan Moguš, Slavko Pavešić, Ivo Škarić, Stjepko Težak: „Povijesni pregled, glasovi i oblici hrvatskoga književnog jezika“. Zbor navedenih gramatika nije slučajni. To su najprezentativnije gramatike srpskohrvatskog jezika, i one na najbolji način odražavaju stanje kako današnje serbokroatističke gramatičke misli tako i njen razvoj u posljednjih pola stoljeća. Sve navedene gramatike jesu opisno-normativne gramatike srpskohrvatskog jezika. U svim tim gramatikama imenice se analiziraju u različitim poglavljima, i iz različitih aspekata: u poglavlju o morfologiji, o leksikologiji, o tvorbi riječi i sintaksi. U ovome radu nećemo se baviti svim tim gramatičkim aspektima imenica. U okviru analize našega rada ulazi samo morfološka obrada imenica, dok u potpunosti izostaju

*tvorbeni, leksikološki i sintaksički aspekti obrade imenica u navedenim gramatikama. Drukčije rečeno, u ovome radu interesuje nas samo način obrade imenica kao vrste riječi u navedenim gramatikama. Cilj rada je da se izdvoje kriteriji koje su autori gramatika primjenjivali u morfološkom opisu imenica kao vrste riječi, pri čemu će se, u prvome redu, ukazivati na podudarnost i nepodudarnost ne samo kriterija nego i rješenja pri opisu pojedinih morfoloških aspekata imenica u navedenim gramatikama.*
